**When:** June 23-25, 2020

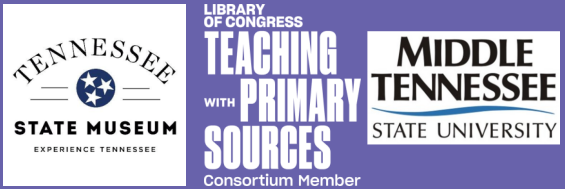
